

About the Author: After attending Wheaton College, Peter Alan Olsson trained at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston. Following his internship in mixed medicine at the University of Vermont, he took a psychiatry residency at Baylor (1968 to 1971), and later was a psychiatrist at Oakland Naval Hospital from 1971 to 1973, where he ran the substance abuse unit and worked with POWs returning from Vietnamese prisons. Dr. Olsson graduated from the Houston-Galveston Psychoanalytic Institute, and practiced psychiatry and psychotherapy while teaching psychotherapy in Houston for 25 years. He was an assistant professor of psychiatry at Dartmouth Medical School and an adjunct professor of clinical psychiatry at Baylor College of Medicine.
