


These Books Are Killers! Author 'Strikes' Again With 2 Suspense Thrillers

The main character is FBI Agent Jimmy Blake, while Steve Striker, the predominant character and villain of the first two books, continues with his career of crime. With Jimmy's unique style of profiling, he quickly advances in the agency and is assigned to the serial murders in the northern part of the state, marking his first case as head agent.

Jimmy's personal and emotional problems play into the suspense, and at times he appears to be controlled by Striker.
